

REMEMBERING Kimberly Joktan

Kimberly Joktan (NEE Borsheim) was born in Kindersley, Saskatchewan to Leonard & Violet Borsheim. She passed away peacefully in her sleep, in Penticton, with her family at her side.

When Kimberly was two years old, her parents joined the many pioneering families moving to the Peace River Country. They settled near Grande Prairie, Alberta and she and her six siblings grew up there, on the farm.
